



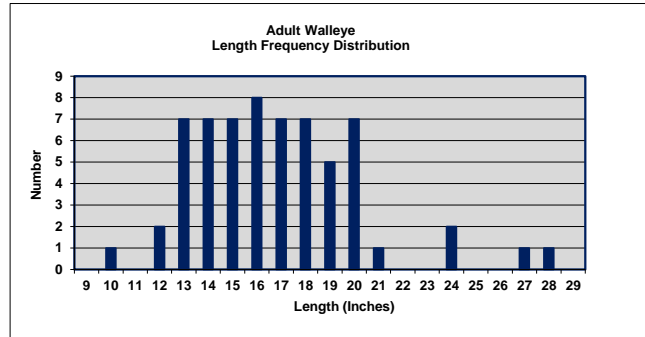

AMIK LAKE, PRICE COUNTY 2018**

The WDNR conducted a fisheries assessment of Amik Lake, Price County from May 6 to May 7, 2018.

Amik Lake is 224 acre drainage lake with a maximum depth of 8 feet. The fishery includes panfish, muskellunge, largemouth bass, northern pike, and walleye. Amik Lake was estimated to contain 200 adult walleye or 0.9 walleye per acre.

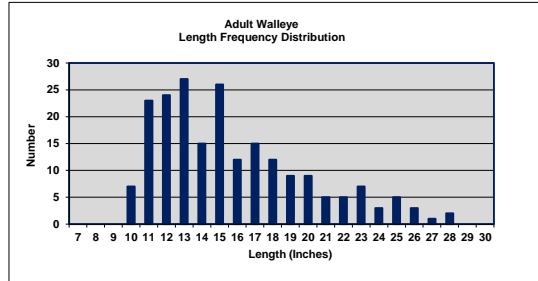

The WDNR conducted a fisheries assessment of Pike Lake, Price County from May 6 to May 9, 2018.

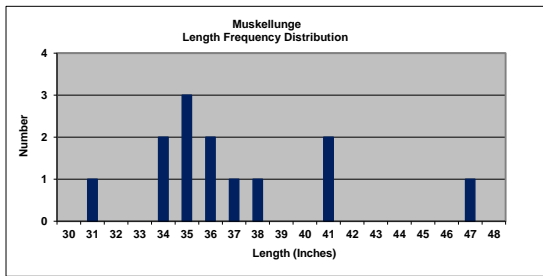
Pike Lake is 806 acre drainage lake with a maximum depth of 17 feet. The fishery includes panfish, muskellunge, northern pike, largemouth bass, smallmouth bass and walleye. Pike Lake was estimated to contain 761 adult walleye or 0.9 walleye per acre.

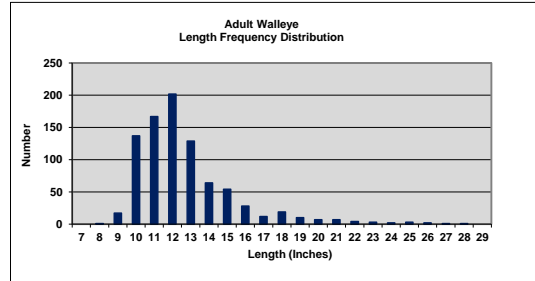

ROUND LAKE, PRICE COUNTY 2018**

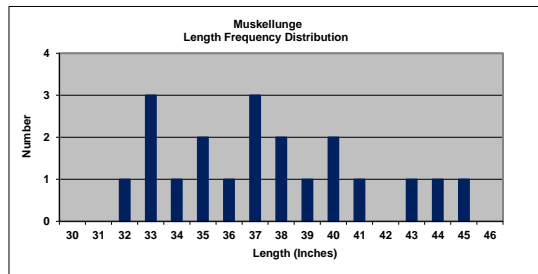
The WDNR conducted a fisheries assessment of Round Lake, Price County from May 6 to May 9, 2018. Round Lake is a 726 acre drainage lake with a maximum depth of 24 feet. The fishery includes panfish, muskellunge, northern pike, largemouth bass, smallmouth bass and walleye. Round Lake was estimated to contain 1532 adult walleye or 2.1 walleye per acre.

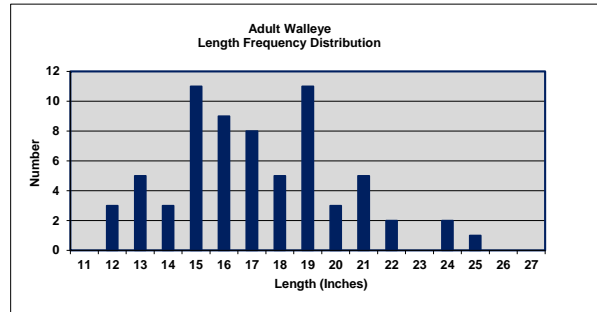

The WDNR conducted a fisheries assessment of Turner Lake, Price County from May 6 to May 7, 2018. Turner Lake is 149 acre drainage lake with a maximum depth of 12 feet. The fishery includes panfish, muskellunge, northern pike, largemouth bass and walleye. Turner Lake was estimated to contain 148 adult walleye or 1.0 walleye per acre.
